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1 Getting Started...

This manual is designed to offer a complete tour of PocketMac iPod Edition™. So, let's get started...

Important Notice: As the iPod doesn't allow editing of its built-in contacts, notes and other features, this program is set up to be a one-way sync. In other words, this program will copy contacts, calendar events, tasks, notes from the Mac to the iPod only.

1.1 Basic System Requirements

Please ensure that your system meets the following basic requirements before using PocketMac iPod Edition.

- OS X 10.2.6 and above
- iTunes 4.x
- Entourage 10.1.4 or better

If it does, we're all set to go!

1.2 Install/Uninstall

Please note: You can install PocketMac iPod Edition on up to 3 machines - either Mac or PC - of your choosing.

To install PocketMac iPod Edition on your Mac, unpack the SIT or HQX file you downloaded and double-click on the PocketMaciPod icon the file unpacks. PocketMac iPod Edition installation requires administrative privileges, so you are next prompted to enter your password or phrase.

This is the username/password you created when you set up your Mac for the very first time.

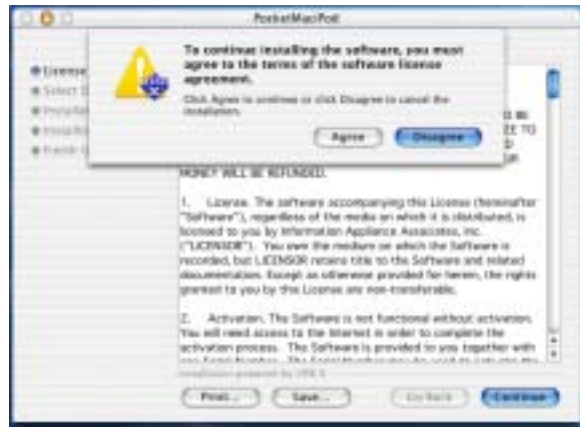


If you are attempting to install PocketMac iPod Edition using an account on your Mac that does not have administrative privileges, installation will fail at this point. You must install PocketMac iPod Edition using a user account on your Mac that has administrative privileges.

When the setup program starts, you'll be asked to look over the license. Once you've read over the agreement and if you agree to the license, just click the "Continue" button.



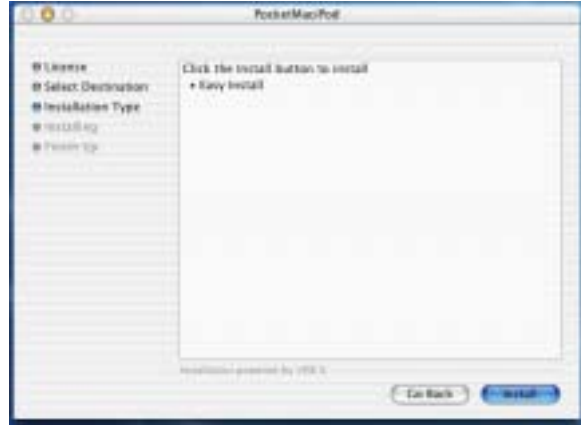
When you press the "Continue" button, you'll be asked to "Agree" or "Disagree" with the license. If you agree, press "Agree".



Once you have agreed to the license, the PocketMac iPod Edition installation screen appears. This screen lets you select the location on your Mac in which the PocketMac iPod Edition software is installed. The default location is the "Applications" folder on your main hard drive. We recommend that all users install PocketMac iPod Edition to this location; only advanced users should select a different location.



At the bottom of the PocketMac iPod Edition installation screen, the "Continue" option is selected by default. To start the installation, click on the "Continue" button on the lower right side of the installation screen.



After all the files have been copied and the install has been set up, you'll be asked to register the software.

Please note: You must have an active Internet connection to register this software.

You can register the software by entering your name, email address, and the serial number from the confirmation email you received as part of the purchase process. [Click here to have your confirmation email resent.](#) (Please note that serial numbers are case-sensitive. This means that "xyz" is not the same as "XYZ" nor "xYz", etc.) **We highly recommend copying (Ctrl + "C") from the confirmation email and pasting (Ctrl+"V") the serial number to ensure no errors in transcribing it.**



The Register Software window will connect to the Internet and "activate" the software for this Macintosh. Each serial number can be activated on a maximum of two Macintoshes and on a maximum of two Windows PCs.

The setup will automatically quit at this point if the Register Software window is unable to activate the software.

When you're done entering your registration information, click the Register button to activate the software.

Once you've registered the software and the software has been installed, click the "Quit" button and you'll be all set!



If you should later decide to *uninstall* PocketMac iPod Edition, double-click on the PocketMac iPod icon. You will be prompted for your Mac system password; enter it. When the PocketMac iPod Edition installation screen appears, select "Uninstall" from the dropdown menu box in the upper left side of the PocketMac iPod Edition installation screen. Next, click "Uninstall" from the lower right side of the PocketMac iPod Edition installation screen. When install has concluded, select "Quit" from the lower right side of the screen.

2 Connect Your iPod To Your Mac

Now that you've installed PocketMac iPod Edition, we recommend you connect your iPod to your Mac and wait until it's recognized on the Mac. Once it's recognized, you're ready to start PocketMac iPod Edition.



3 Launching PocketMac iPod Edition for the First Time

Please note: PocketMac iPod Edition is an iSync plug-in. It works from within iSync.

3.1 PIM Data

To start PocketMac iPod Edition, go into your "Applications" folder and start iSync.

To customize PocketMac iPod Edition, click on the "PM iPod" icon. This will allow you to change all the options to meet your specific needs and to decide if you want all, or only some of the sync options.

In the first tab, "PIM Data", you can check what parts of Entourage you would like to sync. There are three options you can set to be synched.

- 1) Entourage Contacts
- 2) Entourage Calendar
- 3) Entourage Tasks



3.2 Notes

To sync once you've set your options, click the "Sync Now" button.

If you click the next tab "Notes", you'll see additional options for syncing data to your iPod. You can check what Notes items you would like to sync to your iPod.

- 1) Entourage Notes
- 2) Stickies Notes



3.3 Documents

If you click the next tab "Documents", you'll have the option to sync documents from your Mac to the "Notes" section on the iPod.

To enable a "Documents" sync, click the checkbox next to "Documents from folder:". To set the specific Mac folder that PocketMac iPod Edition will sync from your Mac to your iPod, click the "Choose" button and you'll be able to set the folder.



3.4 E-Mail

In the final tab in PocketMac iPod Edition, you'll be able to enable the syncing of E-Mail between your Mac and your iPod's "Notes" folder.

PocketMac iPod Edition will sync only new unread email in your inbox.

You will see a radio box in this tab with three options:

- 1) Entourage E-Mail
- 2) Mail.app E-Mail
- 3) No E-Mail

At this point, all you have to do is select which application's email you'd like to sync or if you would like to not sync any email, just select "No E-Mail."



3.5 Starting The Sync

To sync this data after enabling the options you'd like, click the "Sync Now" button.

You're now all ready to go!



4 Accessing Your Data On Your iPod

Once you've synched all the data you want from your PC to your iPod, you can access it on the road. Here's how...

4.1 Basic Navigation Through The iPod

To access any of the data you've synched on your iPod, here's some basic points on navigating through the iPod.

Click Wheel: To highlight a particular menu item, take your finger and scroll the click wheel (in the accompanying picture, highlighted in red) to the item you'd like to highlight in the menu. Then click the button in the middle of the click wheel.

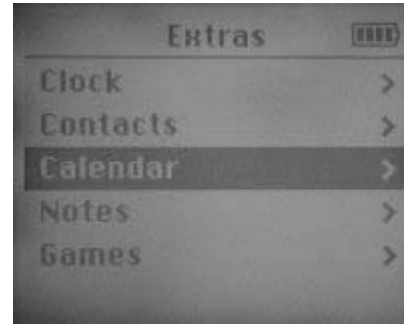


Menu Button: To go back to a previous menu, click the "Menu" button. This will take care of it for you!



4.2 Accessing Calendar Events on The iPod

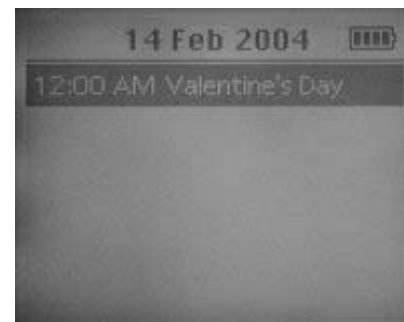
To access Calendars from the main window of your iPod, scroll down to the "Extras" menu. Click the button in the middle of the click wheel. Then click on "Calendar", as shown here.



The iPod will then display a monthly view. To select an individual calendar day, scroll through the calendar and when you've found the day you want to select, click the button in the middle of the click wheel.

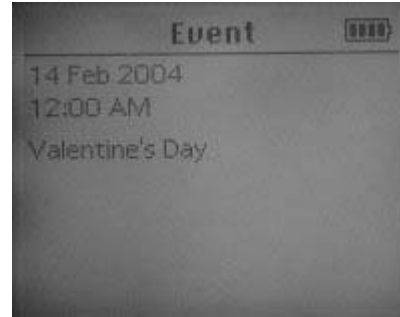


The iPod will display a scrollable list of events on the day you've selected. Once you've scrolled to the item you'd like to select, click the button in the middle of the click wheel.



The iPod will then display the full information on this specific event.

You may now use the menu button to return to the calendar month view.

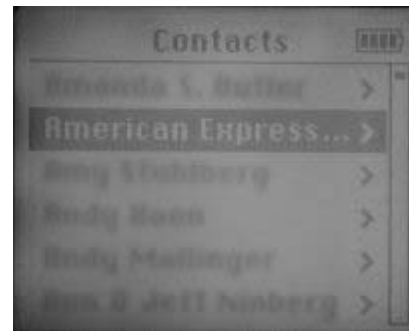


4.3 Accessing Contacts on The iPod

To access Contacts from the main window in your iPod, scroll down to the "Extras" menu. Click the button in the middle of the click wheel. Then click on "Contacts", as shown here.



The iPod will display a complete, scrollable list of contacts. To select an individual contact, scroll through the contacts to the one you want and then click the button in the middle of the click wheel.



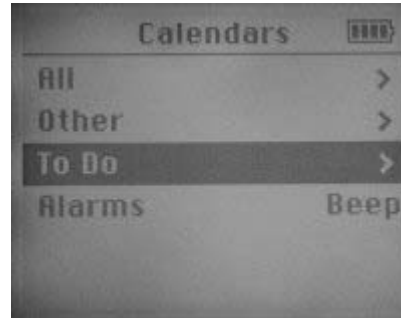
The iPod will display the full details of the selected contact.

You may now use the menu button to return to the contact list.

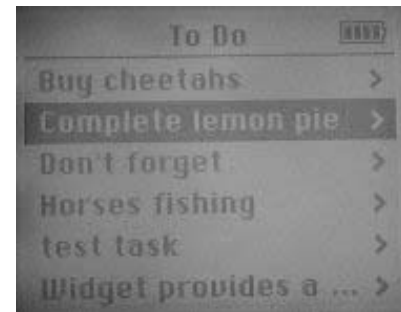


4.4 Accessing Tasks on The iPod

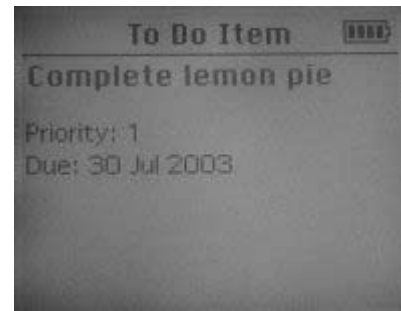
To access Tasks from the main window in your iPod, scroll down to the "Extras" menu. Click the button in the middle of the click wheel. Then click on "Calendar". Then click on "To Do", as shown here.



The iPod will display a complete, scrollable list of tasks. To select an individual task, scroll through the tasks you have and when you've found the item you want to select, click the button in the middle of the click wheel.

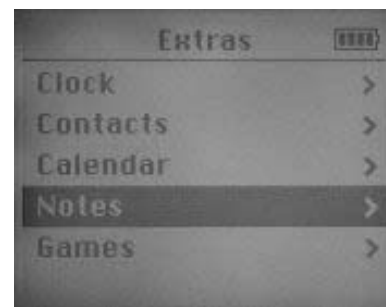


The iPod will display the full details of each task.

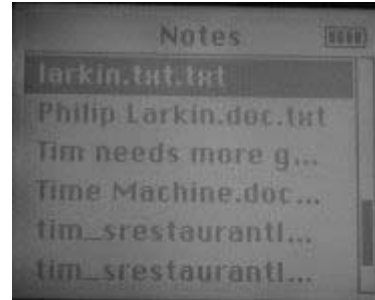


4.5 Accessing Documents on The iPod

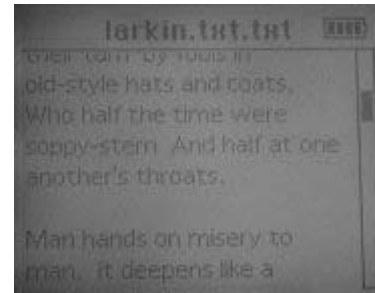
To access the documents you synced to your iPod, scroll down to the "Extras" menu from the main menu. Click the button in the middle of the click wheel. Then click on "Notes", as shown here.



The iPod will display a complete, scollable list of the notes on your iPod. To select an individual document, scroll through the documents you have and when you've found the item you want to select, click the button in the middle of the click wheel.

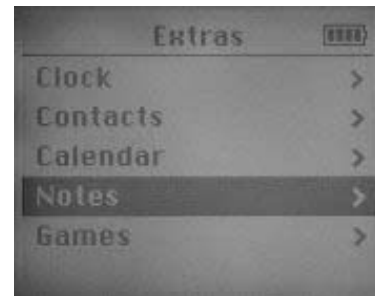


The iPod will display the scrollable contents of the selected document.

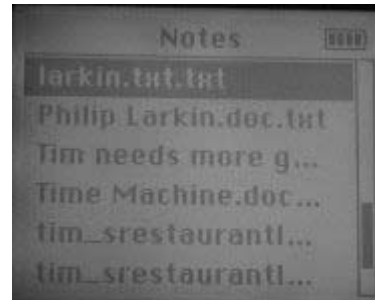


4.6 Accessing Notes On The iPod

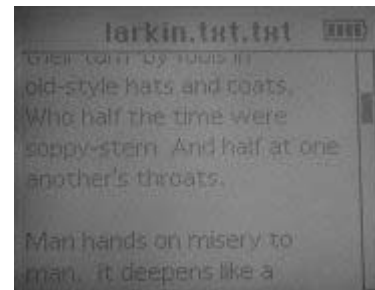
To access the notes you synced to your iPod, scroll down to the "Extras" menu from the main menu. Click the button in the middle of the click wheel. Then click on "Notes".



You will be able to see a complete list of the notes on your iPod. To select an individual document, scroll through the documents you have and when you've found the item you want to select, click the button in the middle of the click wheel.



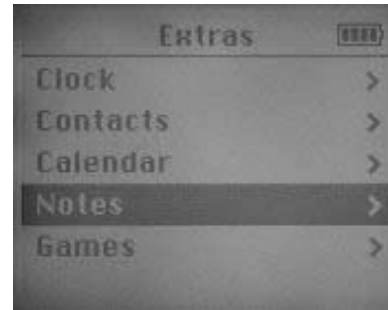
You will be able to be able to see the full details of each document.



4.7 Accessing Synced E-Mail On The iPod

To access the e-mail messages you synced to your iPod, scroll down to the "Extras" menu from the main menu. Click the button in the middle of the click wheel. Then click on "Notes".

You will be able to see a folder called "Mail" in amongst the notes you have on your iPod. Select the "Mail" folder and click the button in the middle of the scroll wheel. Then scroll through and when you find the email message you'd like read, click on it with the button in the middle of the click wheel.

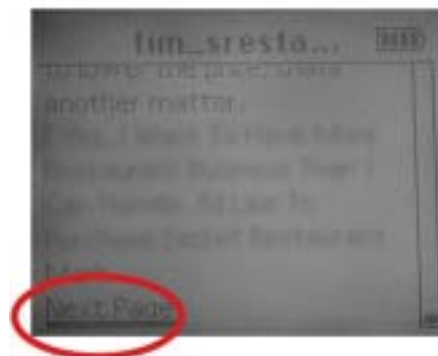


4.8 A Word on Large Note & Document Files

Large notes (greater than 4K) will be displayed as multi-part individual notes. That is, "mynote.txt" becomes "mynote0.txt", "mynote1.txt" and so on.

However, PocketMac iPod Edition is careful to "link" the notes (similar to the way web pages are linked) such that when you reach the end of the first part, a "Next Page" link will appear, as highlighted here.

Simply click the button in the middle of the click wheel, and the iPod will automatically display the next part of the document.



The 4K size is a limitation imposed by the iPod; its note viewing software can only display 4K at once.
